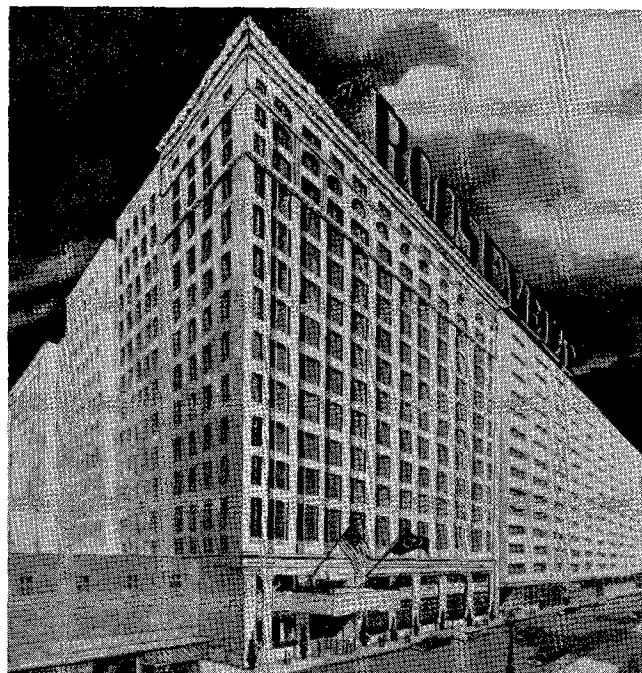

Set For Titles, Abstracts

The Roosevelt Hotel in New Orleans will be the scene of the 55th Annual Meeting of the American Oil Chemists' Society, April 19-22, 1964. With the highly successful Fall Meeting in Minneapolis now a memory, it is not too soon to start planning for NEW ORLEANS—NEXT SPRING.

General Chairman R. T. O'Connor and his able committeemen are now busy setting the stage for a successful and enjoyable convention. The Technical Program Committee, under the capable leadership of H. P. Dupuy, of the Southern Utilization Research and Development Division, is developing a symposium on analyses of unusual or minor constituents of fats and oils, while biodegradable detergents



will be the subject of a symposium being organized by M. E. Ginn and Eric Jungermann.

In addition, R. B. Alfn-Slater is planning a symposium on diet in relation to obesity. J. P. Krumbein is preparing a symposium on tall oil, and M. R. Sahasrabudhe is developing a symposium on chemical oxidation and polymerization of fats and oils.

### Deadline for Abstracts—Prior to Jan. 20, 1964

In addition to the symposia, Chairman Dupuy and his committee cordially invite the submission by the membership of technical papers in their fields of interest for presentation at the Spring Meeting. Papers covering subjects such as chemical reactions, analytical and physical properties, soaps and detergents, processing and utilization, general and instrumental analysis, biochemistry and nutrition, coatings and polymers, and general properties of fats and oils will be welcomed. Authors planning to present papers are urgently requested to submit a 100-300 word abstract of the paper, together with title, authors names, and name of the person who will present the paper at the meeting before January 20, 1964.
