41st International Congress of Seed Crushers Meeting in Amsterdam

Attended by 540 delegates from 27 countries, the 41st International Seed Crushers' Congress was opened in Amsterdam, June 4, by the Netherlands Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, His Excellency V. G. M. Marijnen. Work of the past year was reviewed and reports given by Committees on Contracts and Shipping Documents, Transport, Quality (Edible Oils) and Quality (Technical Oils).

Papers presented at the Congress included: "Oils & Fats in the World Economy" (Netherlands); "The Baltic Exchange" (Great Britain); "Cooperation & Consultation in Trade & Industry in the Netherlands"; "The World Oils & Fats Position" (Great Britain); "Report from the United States"; "Future Markets in Soybeans and Their Products" (United States); and "The Olive Oil Industry" (Italy).

Next year's Congress will be held in Weisbaden, Germany, June 10-12.
