



## Post-Meeting Fiesta Holiday—Olé!

Your holiday in Mexico is waiting! It's not later than you think . . . Plan now to attend the 58th Spring Meeting in New Orleans and top it off with a "Fiesta Holiday."

Monarch Travel has mailed applications and brochures and is handling all travel arrangements for both the New Orleans meeting and the Fiesta Holiday, in cooperation with the North Central Section of the AOCS. All members are urged to complete their plans as soon as possible.

The AOCS group flight will leave Chicago for New Orleans May 7 on Delta flight 861 at 11:00 a.m., arriving at 1:05 p.m. Special waiting and boarding areas are reserved, special handling tags will be provided, and refreshments will be served. A section of the airplane is reserved in order that members may travel together.



The Spring Meeting is being held in the "Most Interesting City in the USA," famous for its fine restaurants, Old French Quarter and Dixieland Jazz. Those not continuing on to Mexico may return to Chicago either May 10 or 11, or may have other arrangements made to suit their needs.

Members who plan to relax in Mexico after the intensive days of the meeting will be able to depart as a group from New Orleans on Eastern flight 905, leaving May 10 at 6:55 p.m., arriving in Mexico City at 8:56 p.m. Everything has been carefully planned by Monarch Travel to assure everyone of a spectacular four-day stay.

Accommodations are at the Del Prado, a first class hotel in the heart of the



city. English-speaking guides will transfer members to the hotel and provide assistance with luggage and customs. The first tour will be May 11 for one-half day. Private cars will drive to Shrine of Guadalupe, the Pyramids of the Sun and Moon and visit other remnants of pre-Aztec culture.

A half-day tour of Mexico City's highlights will be given May 12—the Governmental Palace, the University, lovely Chapultepec Park and the Castle.

Each day is planned with ample free time for individual activities. Although Saturday is left entirely open, many may wish to take advantage of optional tours—night life, Indian villages, Cuernavaca and Taxco.

Return from Mexico is scheduled for Sunday at 9:30 a.m. on Mexicana flight 800, arriving in Chicago at 1:20 p.m. Arrangements can be made for a longer stay if desired.

An invitation is also given to members of AOCS from other areas. Monarch Travel will be happy to provide arrangements to and from any city in the United States.

The New Orleans and Mexico City combination offers a special reason for AOCS members to bring their wives to the approaching meeting, since the "fiesta holiday" offers an unique opportunity for a change of pace.
