

Vacation in Indies After 1970 AOCS Meeting

Here is your chance to treat yourself and to enjoy superb scenery, beautiful beaches, fragrant foliage and relaxed living at its best. Hear the Calypso beat in its native land; see the tropical countryside, tour the banana plantations, the Old Sugar Mill and swim in the Caribbean. Travel across Jamaica, stopping overnight at Ocho Rios (Eight Rivers); see Dunn River Falls, waterfall walking, and picnic near this 600-foot waterfall. Stay in Kingston and visit its bulging native bazaar, the botanical gardens or the old forts and museums.

Depart for the Netherland Antilles and Curaçao just 40 miles from the South American Coast. Curaçao is Dutch, Latin and scenic. It is old and steeped in its own exciting brew of Dutch, French, Spanish and English adventure. Visit old forts, plantations, cactus forest, the oldest synagogue in the Western Hemisphere, and the ancient "land house." Local merchants offer unlimited treasures in Curaçao at prices often lower than in the countries where they are made. Shopping becomes a vacation highlight.

Cost, including four nights in Jamaica and three nights in Curaçao will be about \$535 including hotels with Modified American Plan and return to Miami. Only proof of citizenship (birth certificate) is needed for identification. If you leave at Kingston the cost will be about \$395.
