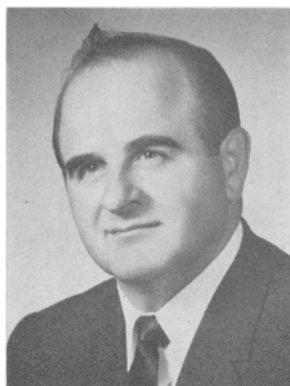

FULL DAY SYMPOSIUM ON THE TECHNOLOGY OF FATTY ACIDS

The Northeast Section of the AOCS is sponsoring a full day technical symposium on The Technology of Fatty Acids at the Hotel Robert Treat on April 13, 1971. The technical program will consist of five speakers presenting topics on Fatty Acid Chemistry, Applications and Processing. Subjects as outlined below are of current interest to chemists, engineers, application product development, sales personnel and all AOCS members interested in fatty acid technology.

In addition to the technical program, Ben Slocum, guest luncheon speaker, will talk on the problems of "Current Labor Relations." Mr. Slocum, Director of Personnel at the Drew Chemical Company will review labor contracts and negotiation procedures in the fatty oil and chemical industry. Mr. Slocum is directly involved in negotiations and writing of labor contracts and will bring us up to date on the labor picture in the chemical industry.

The speakers and subjects of the technical program are:

1. Richard Reck, Manager, Commercial Chemical Development Department, Armour Industrial Chemical Company. Mr. Reck will present a paper on Fatty Nitrogen Derivatives.

2. R. W. Johnson, Manager of Product Development, Chemical Division, Union Camp Corporation, will talk on Tall Oils and Tall Oil Fatty Acids. The presentation will cover the past, present and future of fatty acids from tall oils. Union Camp Corp. is one of the leaders in tall oil technology and marketing and can, therefore, present an excellent picture of today's market and the future of the tall oil fatty acids.

3. A. E. Rohl, Technical Supervisor, Industrial and Tall Oil Chemicals, Hercules Incorporated. Mr. Rohl will present a talk on "A New Generation of Fatty Acids from Tall Oil." Presentation will center around the important properties and end use applications of a new series of oleic, linoleic and conjugated fatty acids derived from tall oil fatty acids.

4. M. Fefer, Chemical Intermediates Department, Long Range Planning Division, Enjay Chemical Company. Dr. Fefer will present a talk on the current status of Neo Fatty Acids being produced by the petroleum oil companies and effect on the fatty acid market.

5. Peter Kalustian, Engineer, Management Consultant and Consulting Engineer to the Fats, Oils and Food Industry. Mr. Kalustian will present a talk on the Processing of Fatty Acids. In conjunction with the talk, a panel of processing experts will answer questions from the audience on the technology and processing of fatty acids.

The cost for the all day symposium, including luncheon, is \$7.00 for members of the Northeast Section of AOCS and \$8.00 for other participants. Students will be charged \$4.00.
