## CALL FOR NOMINATIONS HONORED STUDENT AWARDS FOR 1972

Nominations are solicited and will be accepted until February 21, 1972 for AOCS Honored Student Awards for that year. Graduate students at any North American institution of higher learning, in any area of science dealing with fats and lipids, who are doing research toward an advanced degree, and who are interested in the areas of science and technology fostered by this Society are eligible. In addition, the student must be a registered graduate student at the time of application and must not have taken his final examination for an advanced degree by the time of the award. Selection of awardees is on the basis of educational qualifications and performance.

The awards provide funds equal to travel plus reasonable expenses incurred by attendance at a national meeting of the AOCS. In 1972 these meetings will be held April 23-26 in Los Angeles and September 24-28 in Ottawa. Students will be awarded travel to the nearer meeting to allow as many awards as possible from available funds.

Nomination forms may be obtained from the national office of the AOCS or from the Chairman of the Honored Student Award Committee.
