

## Northeast Section honors Ernest F. Drew

An AOCS Northeast Section meeting, organized by Frank Naughton, was held February 13, 1973, at the Chemists' Club in New York City. Speaker for the evening was Peter Kalustian on "The Story of the Drew Company."

Kalustian's talk covered the origin and remarkable growth of Drew Chemical, which has an enviable record of innovations in its field. 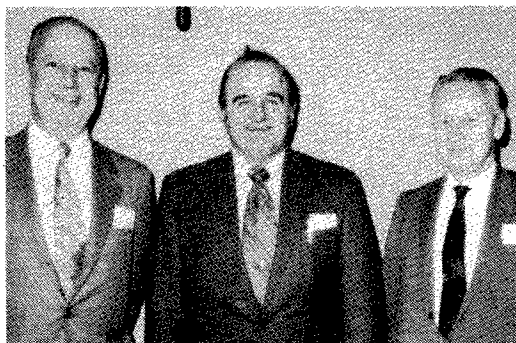
