Society offers free trip to Mexico City

To add impetus to the already successful AOCS President's Club and Honor Roll membership campaign, the Society's Governing Board announced in New Orleans a special prize drawing for all members who recruit at least one new member during the 1973 membership year.

The President's Club and Honor Roll, announced in early 1973, resulted in the approval of 246 new member applications at the New Orleans meeting. This is more than double the usual number approved by the Governing Board at the annual spring meeting. In addition, nearly 100 new applications have been received since that time.

To date, 15 members have qualified for the Honor Roll by recruiting at least three new members. These individuals and any new qualifiers will receive special framed certificates at the fall meeting in Chicago. Leading recruiters at this point are E.G. Perkins with nine new members and J.G. Endres with six. Also, another 111 members have qualified for the President's Club by recruiting one or two new members. No specific goals have been set for the campaign. Its purpose is to help the Society grow through a program which, in effect, appoints every AOCS member to the Membership Committee.
