

Kalustian designated winner of NE Section Achievement Award

At the first meeting of the 1973-74 season September 11th, at the Robin Hood Inn, Clifton, N.J., the Northeast Section presented its Achievement Award to Peter Kalustian. Kalustian, who is a professional engineer, management consultant and consulting engineer, worked with Drew Chemical Corporation for about 36 years and, on his retirement in 1970, was general management and group vice-president of that company with complete responsibility for all food, fat and edible oil product operations.
