

President's Club/Honor Roll continues to grow

Prizes announced for membership campaign drive

The AOCS membership campaign for 1974 is reaching its final stages. Those individuals who have recruited at least one new member since the 1973 Spring meeting in Chicago are members of the President's Club and automatically become eligible for a prize drawing to be held at the Annual Fall Meeting Banquet in Philadelphia, October 1, 1974. Members will receive one chance for each new member recruited.

Prizes to be awarded in Philadelphia are: first prize, round trip air fare for one from any point in the continental U.S. to Dallas, plus three nights' lodging at the Statler Hilton, the Spring Meeting hotel; second prize, three piece set of Samsonite luggage, including a men's three suiter, a companion case, and an attache case; third prize, Samsonite attache case.

In addition, all 1974 President's Club members will be guests of the Governing Board at a special reception in Philadelphia.

Members who recruit at least three new members become automatically eligible for the President's Honor Roll. In addition to the benefits of the President's Club, Honor Roll members will receive an engraved, framed certificate.

The 1974 campaign is running well ahead of previous years. In Mexico City, the Governing Board approved the applications of 315 new members as opposed to 223 a year ago.

Standards catalog published; available free of charge

The 1974 catalog of American National Standards and international standards has been published by the American National Standards Institute.

More than 5,600 American National Standards and 3,000 international standards and recommendations are listed in the 176-page catalog. Included are all American National Standards approved by ANSI through October 31, 1973, and all international standards and recommendations received by ANSI last year from the International Organization for Standardization (ISO), the International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC), and the International Commission on Rules for the Approval of Electrical Equipment (CEE).

The catalog also lists special ANSI publications of interest to those working in the field of standardization. They deal with the standards aspects of such subjects as metric conversion, consumer affairs, and occupational safety and health. Also included in the catalog is a 25-page index to

the standards and information and how to order them.

Anyone wanting a copy of the catalog may contact the Institute's Sales Department at 1430 Broadway, New York, New York 10018. The catalogs are available free of charge.

The American National Standards Institute is the national clearinghouse and coordinating agency for voluntary standardization in the U.S. It approves a standard when it receives evidence that all parties having a substantial interest in the scope and provisions of a particular standard have been given an opportunity to cooperate in the standard's development or to comment on its provisions. ■

Hercules announces expansion plans

Hercules Inc. announced plans to expand its pentaerythritol plant at Louisiana, Mo., to provide a 15-20 per cent increase in production capacity. The expansion will be completed by the second quarter of 1975.

The increased capacity is needed to serve expanding markets for pentaerythritol, which is used in the manufacture of synthetic resins for protective coatings, inks, and adhesives, and as a chemical intermediate. ■
