



Visit Philadelphia with AOCS

This heroic-sized statue of William Penn (37 feet tall) stands on top of the Tower of Philadelphia's City Hall, 548 feet above street level. The statue weighs more than 26 tons. Penn's hat is 9 feet in diameter, his middle finger is 2½ feet long. Penn founded the City of Philadelphia and the State of Pennsylvania. The statue is just one of many sights you will see when you visit Philadelphia with AOCS.
