**Seven Receive Bond Award**

The AOCs Bond Award Committee has announced that Harold S. Olcott, presenting author, has won the Bond Award Gold Medal, and James S. Lin, coauthor, has won the first place certificate for their paper, “Free Radical Intermediates of Antioxidants.”

Olcott is a professor and Lin a research associate at the Institute of Marine Resources at the University of California, Davis.

Second place winners Joe C. Christian, K.W. Kang, and W.E. Nance, all of the Department of Medical Genetics at the Indiana University School of Medicine in Indianapolis, received honorable mentions for their paper, “Plasma Cholesterol in Newborn Human Twins.”

Thomas E. Furia, director of Food Science at Dynapol, Palo Alto, CA, and N. Bellanca, also of Dynapol, received honorable mentions for their third place paper, “Non-absorbable Polymeric Antioxidants for Use in Foods.”

All papers were presented at the 66th Annual Spring Meeting in Dallas.

The Bond Award, established in 1958, recognizes excellence of both delivery and content of papers presented at each of the two AOCs national meetings. Papers are judged solely on the merits of their presentations, not written manuscripts. Both session chairmen and the audience rate the talks on the basis of organization, understandability, delivery, visual aids (if any), timing, and technical quality. ■
