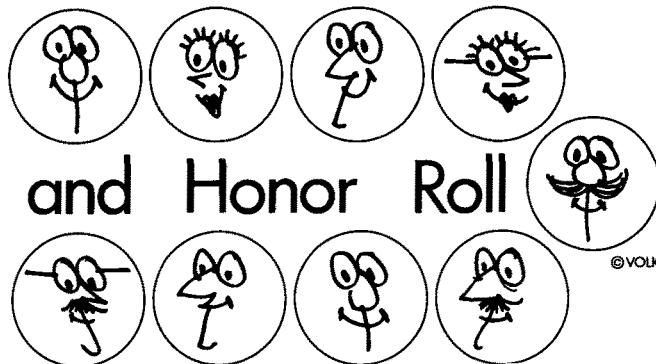




President's Club

Prizes added for 1975 President's Club-Honor Roll

In the past, special recognition and awards have been given, through the President's Club-Honor Roll, to AOCs members who successfully recruit new members to the Society. In 1975, additional prizes will be presented to the best recruiters of new members in each of four membership categories.

A \$100 U.S. Savings Bond will be awarded to the current AOCs member who recruits the most new members in the active, individual associate, active junior, and corporate categories.
