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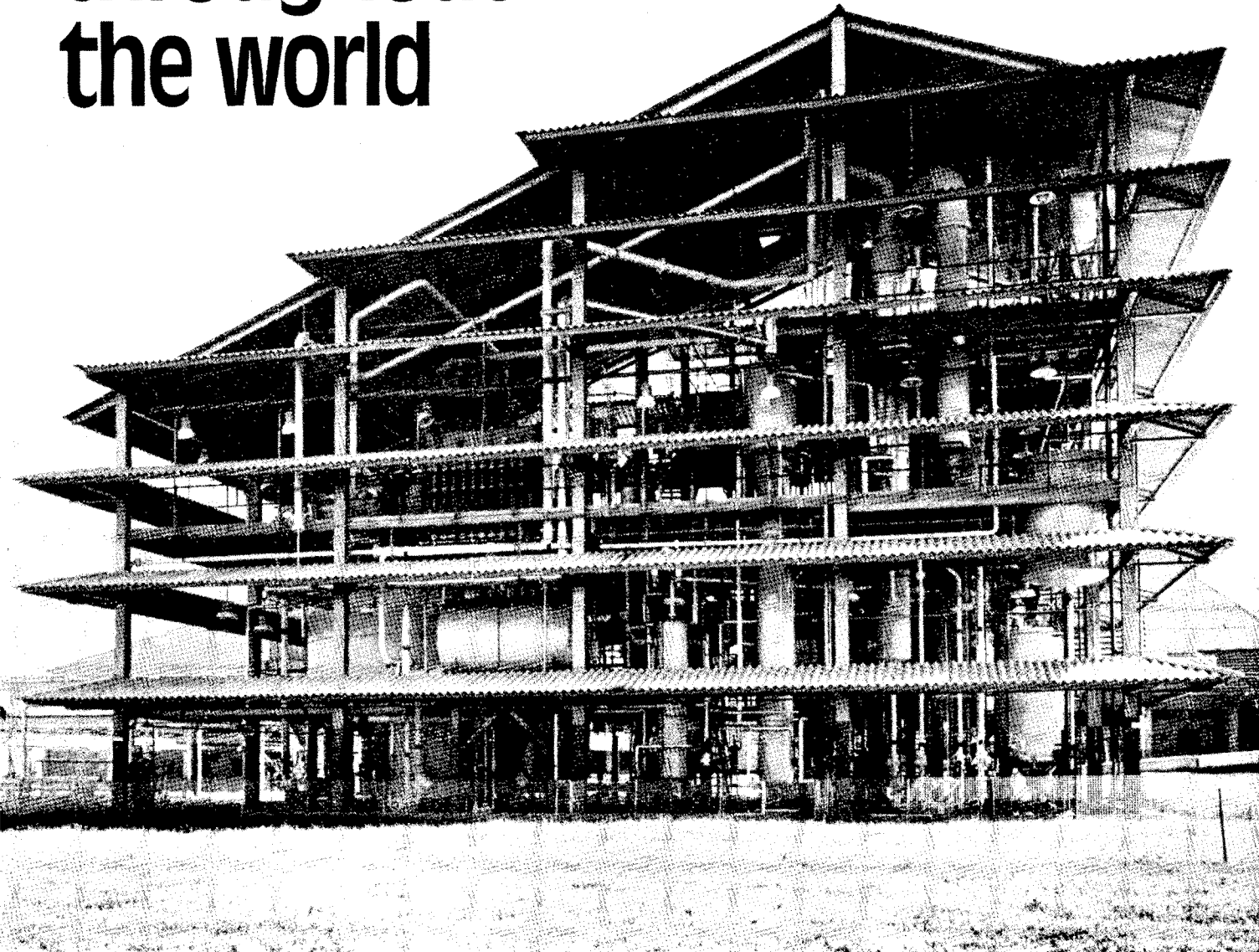

Malaysia to Host International Palm Oil Conferences

The Malaysian Agricultural Research and Development Institute (MARDI), the Oil Palm Growers' Council (OPGC), and the Malaysian Palm Oil Producers' Association (MPOPA) will sponsor the Malaysian International Conferences on Oil Palm and Palm Oil, to be held June 14-19, 1976, in Kuala Lumpur. The conferences are being organized on behalf of the sponsors by the Incorporated Society of Planters (ISP).

From June 14 to June 17, the Malaysian International Agricultural Oil Palm Conference will be in session, followed by the Malaysian International Symposium on Palm Oil Processing and Marketing on June 17-19. The former will mark the first major meeting of oil palm experts in four years, since the International Conference organized by the ISP in 1972, and the latter is the first of its kind to be held in Malaysia since 1968.

In addition to participants from Malaysia, research workers and other interested parties from the following countries will attend: Australia, Belgium, British Solomon Islands, Burma, Camerouns, Ecuador, France, Germany, Ghana, Honduras, India, Indonesia, Italy, Ivory Coast, Nigeria, Pakistan, Papua New Guinea, Philippines, Singapore, Sweden, Thailand, the United Kingdom, and the United States.
