50th Annual Fall Meeting

Featuring 36 sessions and 185 papers, the 50th Annual Fall Meeting of the American Oil Chemists' Society in Chicago will be supplemented with a variety of diversions and distractions, particularly for the ladies.

At the Tuesday evening banquet, Woody Herman and The Herd will be in concert for one hour, followed by the traditional dancing.

On Monday and Tuesday, the ladies will tour Chicago's points of interest in air-conditioned coaches. On Monday's artistic and historical jaunt, knowledgeable hostess guides will point out such Chicago highlights as Alexander Calder's stabile "Flamingo" (pictured below, top center), Calder's moving mural "Universe" (top right), and Marc Chagall's mosaic wall, "The Four Seasons" (bottom). Later in the day, they will visit the home and studio of artist Mary Gehr Ray, who will lecture on her work and her travels. The

Warehouse, an unusual complex of shops and restaurants, will be the next stop, followed by a tour of Chicago's Historical Society. A complete Chinese luncheon at Lee's restaurant in the Warehouse will complete Monday's adventure.

On Tuesday morning, buses will pick up the ladies at the convention hotel (Hyatt Regency Chicago) and take them through Chicago's North Shore communities, to the Bahai Temple, to Long Grove, Illinois ("The Town That Time Forgot"). The Hobson House in Long Grove will serve the complete buffet luncheons planned for AOCS spouses.

Finally, on Wednesday morning, "The Genie" will entertain at the Hyatt Regency Chicago, with exhibitions and demonstrations of astrology, palmistry, and extrasensory perception.
