

Witco Chemical Corporation today announced it is building a new unit to manufacture Bryton[®], Hybase[®], and M-400 overbased magnesium sulfonates for its Sonneborn Division at the Gretna, LA, plant. Completion of the new unit is anticipated by the end of 1976. Cost was not disclosed. . . . Construction is underway on a new 32,000 sq ft Stepan Chemical Research and Development facility, adjacent to the present research building at the corporate headquarters in Northfield, IL.
