



### "Chorus Line" tickets available

Henry A. Salomon of the Enjoy New York committee for the AOCS Annual Meeting has announced that the committee has acquired a limited number of tickets for "A Chorus Line," one of the most successful Broadway musicals in recent years.

Tickets will be available on a first-come, first-serve basis to prepaid advance registrants for the May 8-12 meeting. The tickets, all orchestra or front mezzanine, cost \$16.50 each for the evening performances Monday, May 9, and Tuesday, May 10. Coupons for ordering tickets will be included in registration material mailed to AOCS members. One ticket will be made available for each prepaid registration for the regular program or the spouses' program. Tickets will be available only to persons registering for the full meeting.

Salomon also said he will try to obtain reservations for four other Broadway productions or the American Ballet Theater for AOCS members requesting them. The four shows are: "California Suite" by Neil Simon; "Chicago," a musical; "Comedians," directed by Mike Nichols; and "The Wiz," a musical. Salomon said tickets for such shows generally cost \$16.50 each for orchestra and front mezzanine seats. The American Ballet theater will be presenting Tchaikovsky's "Sleeping Beauty" the evenings of May 9 and 10 during a limited engagement at the Metropolitan Opera House in Lincoln Center.

The number of papers reflects the fact that this will be the first year in decades in which AOCS has held just one national meeting. Titles, authors, and abstracts are listed in a special insert in this issue of JAOCS.

The volume of papers will require six concurrent technical sessions each morning and afternoon beginning Monday afternoon, May 9, and concluding Thursday morning, May 12. Opening and closing business sessions of AOCS will be held Monday morning and Thursday afternoon.

Besides the technical sessions, the AOCS annual meeting will include presentation of various awards, including the Award in Lipid Chemistry and the Award of Merit, and the installation luncheon of officers to be elected this spring. A full ladies program, including a visit to the United Nations, has been planned.
