Construction contracts announced

French Oil Mill Machinery Co. has announced two new contracts for installation of extraction units in Mexico and the southern United States.

The Mexican unit, using French's Stationary Basket Extractor, is being built to process 200 tons of marigold or 250 tons of soybeans each day. The plant will be for Productoes Deshidratados de Mexico in Los Mochis, Sinola, Mexico.

Marigold will be the 25th product to be processed through one of the French extractors. Marigold is harvested by hand, trucked to the plant site where it is mechanically dewatered, thermally dried, hammer-milled, pelletized, and then subjected to solvent extraction with hexane.

The plant will be partially fabricated by French Oil in Mexico. Start-up for the plant is scheduled for February 1978.

The second contract announced by French is to install, modernize, and expand solvent extract systems at three Southern Cotton Oil Company plants.

An entirely new solvent extraction plant will be built in Memphis with French Oil doing the design and installation of a high capacity 400 tons per day pre-pressed cottonseed cake solvent extraction system.

An additional 400 tons per day solvent extractor is to be added to a plant at Little Rock, AR, to handle pre-pressed cottonseed cake as part of a modernization of that plant.

At a third facility in Greenville, MS, French is expanding and modernizing the plant.

Change in name for tallow lab

The USDA's Eastern Regional Research Center lab for tallow research has changed its name from Animal Fats Products Laboratory to Animal Fat Laboratory, reflecting a decreased emphasis in federal research on industrial uses of fats and oils.

The reorganized lab has four research groups. Applications Research is headed by Dr. Warner M. Linfield, Exploratory Research by Dr. L. S. Silbert, Modifications and Reactions Research by Dr. T.A. Foglia, and Food Lipids Research, by Dr. G. Maerker, who also heads the entire laboratory.

The changes follow sharp reductions in financing for industrial use research on tallow at the Philadelphia center. The new Food Lipids group will work with edible fats, an indication of increased federal emphasis on food, nutrition, and consumer health. Further development of the research on fractionation of beef tallow, previously handled by another ERRC group, will be by the Food Lipids group. Dr. Maerker's group also will work at developing improved methodology for detecting and measuring minor lipid components of animal fats.

Further trends in tallow research will depend on federal budgetary decisions by executive and legislative groups. •



The latest practical technology in soaps and detergents from around the globe will be shared among hundreds of delegates during the World Conference on Soaps and Detergents that opens Oct. 9, 1977, in the Montreux, Switzerland, Convention and Exhibition Centre. Registration deadline is Sept. 1, 1977.

Individually selected speakers from more than a dozen nations across five continents will present formal talks. The formal program will be supplemented by daily informal discussions where registrants may question speakers and also by an exposition of displays by soap and detergent manufacturers as well as suppliers to the industry. The conference will begin with the opening of exhibits on Sunday, Oct. 9.

The American Oil Chemists' Society is sponsoring the meeting with the cooperation of other international organizations. Dr. Karl Zilch of Emery Industries is general chairman for the meeting; Dr. Kurt Gehri of the Union der Seifen- und Waschmittelfabrikanten der Schweiz is local chairman.

The complete technical program is provided on Page 630A of this issue of *JAOCS*. Simultaneous translation of formal talks will be provided in English, French, and German. An English proceedings of the formal talks will be published in *JAOCS*

early next year. Copies will be provided to each registrant. The program has been divided into eight sessions encompassing everything from raw materials in the industry to how developments in related industries or in government may affect the soap and detergent industries of the future.

Registrants from North America may elect to participate in group travel plans arranged by the AOCS. Either plan includes hotel accommodations, including continental breakfast each day during the week of the convention. One plan offers a return flight to the United States on Oct. 15, immediately following the convention; the alternate plan has a return flight Oct. 22, one week after the conference ends. Full details are explained in the travel portion of this special section. Participants flying from New York will fly directly to Geneva. Persons flying from Chicago will make a stop in Boston before continuing to Zurich for a connecting flight to Geneva. Travel will be on a Boeing 747B or a DC-10-30.

Social events will include a Monday evening reception by the town of Montreux. Jean-Jacques Cevey, national councillor and mayor of Montreux, will extend a greeting to participants. On Wednesday afternoon, the conference participants will trek to the famous castle and cheese factory at Gruyeres. A lunch is included in this trip. An optional Swiss Folk Party event has been scheduled for Thursday evening at the Montreux Casino.

The spouses' program will include the Sunday exposition opening, Monday reception, Wednesday visit to Gruyeres, and, as an option, the Thursday Swiss Folk Party. In addition, spouses on Monday are invited to a morning coffee followed by a cogwheel train ride 6,700M into the mountains above Montreux for a lunch at Rochers de Naye. On Tuesday, a full day's excursion to Bern, Switzerland's capital, is planned. Thursday will include local sightseeing, including a visit to Chillon Castle, inspiration for Lord Byron's poem "Prisoner of Chillon." Friday will be an open day for resting, shopping, or other activities.

Post-conference tours, described beginning on Page 640A, will also be available.

Registration deadline for the conference, group travel, and post-conference tours is Sept. 1, although final payment for group travel and post-conference tours is not due until Sept. 16. Registration fees should accompany registration. Persons traveling independently to Montreux (not as part of the AOCS group travel packages), should make hotel reservations by Sept. 15, 1977. Registration, housing, group travel, and post-conference tour forms are available from AOCS, 508 S. Sixth St., Champaign, IL 61820.
