World Conference on Soaps & Detergents October 9-14, 1977 Montreux, Switzerland



Previous quotes were based on international airfares in effect at an earlier date. Current costs reflect changes as of April 1, 1977, when affinity group fares were raised 17.5%. (Cost of a regular tourist class roundtrip ticket from Chicago was boosted to \$891 from \$818 as of April 1, 1977.)

General Information: Group flights are being arranged only from New York and Chicago using regularly scheduled flights of SWISSAIR to Geneva either direct or with a plane change in Zurich. Ground transportation is provided from Geneva to Montreux.

Costs Include: Round trip air fare; 7 nights lodging in Montreux, including breakfasts, taxes and service; round trip transfers between Geneva airport and Montreux. Costs are per person, double occupancy. Single occupancy supplements are quoted below. Prices are based on projected late 1977 air fares and are subject to change. Portions of the package payable in Swiss Francs are based on the rate of exchange as of April 25, 1977.

GIT Groups: (Depart October 7—Return October 15) GIT requires a minimum of five passengers traveling together round trip. Costs are per person, double occupancy. Post-conference tours are not available to GIT travellers.

40-Affinity Groups: (Depart October 7—Return October 22) Affinities require a minimum of 40 eligible passengers traveling together. Members of sponsoring groups and their families are eligible. The affinity package includes hotel in Montreux through October 14 (7 nights). The cost of extra nights in Montreux are quoted below. Post conference tours are coordinated with affinity group schedules.

Single Occupancy Supplement: To obtain a single room, the individual registrant will be required to pay the extra flat fee indicated in addition to the basic group package.

Additional Nights in Montreux: (Affinity groups only) Those wishing to stay in Montreux after the night of October 14 may do so at the extra per person, per night charge quoted below, inclusive of breakfast, taxes, and service.

Deposits, Cancellations and Final Payments: A \$50 per person deposit is required with the reservation. Cancellation by AOCs at any time and by passengers by September 21, 1977 will be refunded in full. Cancellations by passengers received after September 21, 1977 will be refunded only to the extent refunds are legally retrievable from the airlines. Final payment is due by September 16, 1977.

The Conference and the IRS: The timing of the travel groups, post-conference tours, and the technical program is coordinated to allow for compliance with United States Internal Revenue Service Regulations on Foreign meetings deductions.

Special Note: Persons using GIT or affinity group travel from New York and Chicago arranged by Doddson Travel, Inc. should *not* use the tri-lingual housing forms designed to be mailed directly to Montreux.

Post-Conference Tours Three Options Open to All Registrants

General Information: Post-conference tours are open to all conference registrants. Persons registering for these tours only (and not for special travel groups described above) must make conference housing arrangements separately by using the special conference housing form or by making special arrangements with Doddson Travel, Inc. All prices are quoted in U.S. dollars equivalent of Swiss francs using the exchange rate of December 21, 1976.

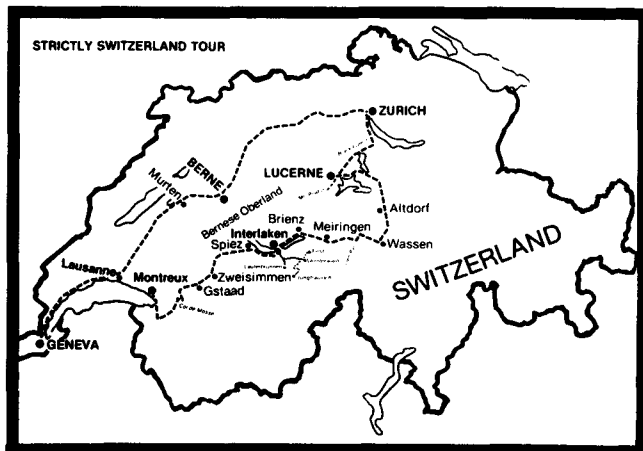
Cost of All Options Included: First class, twin bedded hotel rooms with bath, continental breakfast, taxes, service, and tips on arrival and departure. Deluxe private motor coach from Montreux until arrival at Geneva airport on October 22 (except 1st class rail fare, Venice—Geneva in Option C). Professional escort. Entrance fees. Portage at the airport.

Not Included in the Cost: Lunches, dinners, tips to driver and escort, costs of optional excursions.

Deposits, Cancellations, Final Payments: A \$50 per person fee is required with each reservation. Cancellations by AOCs at any time or by passengers by September 21, 1977 will be refunded in full. Final payment is required by September 16, 1977.

Option A: STRICTLY SWITZERLAND

Cost: \$361 per person, double occupancy. Single Supplement: \$35.



Itinerary:

Oct. 15—Departure Montreux by motorcoach and drive via the Bernese Oberland—Col de Mosse—Gstaad, famous winter sport resort, via Zweisimmen and Spiez to *Interlaken*.

Oct. 16—Excursion by motorcoach to Lauterbrunnen and Grindelwald. Opportunity to take an optional excursion to Jungfrauoch or to First. Overnight *Interlaken*.

Oct. 17—Departure Interlaken by motorcoach and drive via Brienz, (famous for woodcarving), Meiringen, Aare Gorge, Sustan Pass (stop for lunch). Continue via Wassen, Altdorf and the William Tell's Country and via the Axenstrasse to *Lucerne*.

Oct. 18—Forenoon City sightseeing tour of Lucerne, including entrance fees to the Transport Museum.

*Optional excursion to Mt. Pilatus in the afternoon. Overnight *Lucerne*.

Oct. 19—At leisure in *Lucerne* for independent activities.

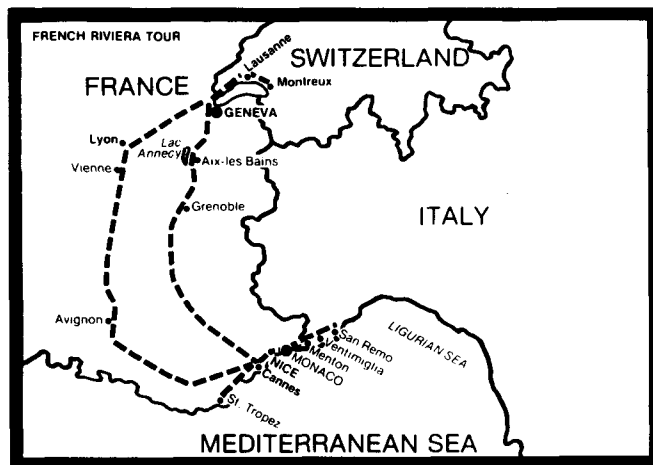
Oct. 20—Departure Lucerne by motorcoach and drive via The Black Forest and Rhine Falls to *Zurich*.

Oct. 21—Departure Zurich and drive to Berne for sightseeing tour (stop for lunch) and continue via Murten and Lausanne to *Geneva*.

Oct. 22—Transfer by motorcoach from hotel to Geneva Airport Cointrin.

Option B: FRENCH RIVIERA

Cost: \$389 per person, double occupancy. Single Supplement: \$40.



Itinerary:

Oct. 15—Departure Montreux by motorcoach and drive via Lausanne, Geneva (short city tour), Lac Annecy, Aix-les Bains and Champéry to *Grenoble*.

Oct. 16—Departure Grenoble and drive by motorcoach via the Route Napoleon to *Monte Carlo*.

Oct. 17—Half-day excursion by motorcoach and local English-speaking guide to Menton, Ventimiglia and San Remo. Overnight *Monte Carlo*.

Oct. 18—Departure Monte Carlo and drive via the Grand Cornich Drive and Nice to *Cannes*.

Oct. 19—Mid-day excursion to St. Tropez (lunch in St. Tropez). Overnight *Cannes*.

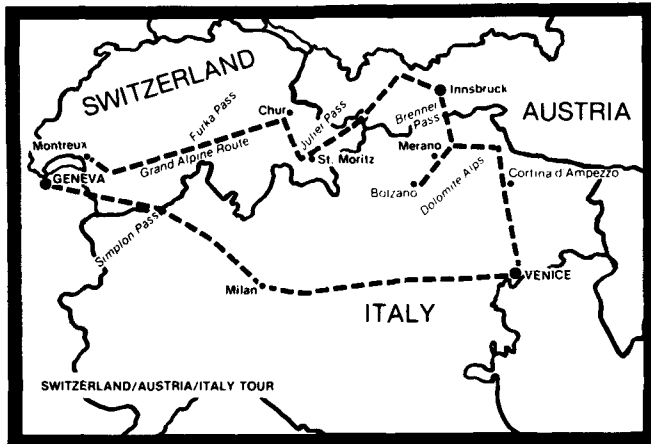
Oct. 20—Half-day shopping excursion to Nice. Overnight *Cannes*.

Oct. 21—Departure Cannes and drive via Avignon and Vienne to *Geneva*.

Oct. 22—Transfer by private motorcoach from hotel to Geneva Airport.

Option C: SWITZERLAND/AUSTRIA/ITALY

Cost: \$415 per person, double occupancy. Single Supplement: \$45.



Itinerary:

Oct. 15—Departure Montreux and drive by motorcoach along the river Rhone via Sierre and Sion to Brigue, continue via Gletsch and Furka Pass (Grand Alpine Route) to Andermatt (stop for lunch). Continue via Oberalppass, Films, Lenzerheide and Julierpass to *St. Moritz*.

Oct. 16—Departure *St. Moritz* and drive through one of the most beautiful valleys of Switzerland, "The Engadin," and through part of the National Park of Switzerland, via Landeck to *Innsbruck*.

Oct. 17—Forenoon city sightseeing tour by private motorcoach including entrance fees. Afternoon at leisure for independent activities. Overnight *Innsbruck*.

Oct. 18—Departure *Innsbruck* and drive via Steinach and the Brenner Pass to Italy. Continue via *St. Leonardo* to *Meran*.

Oct. 19—Departure *Meran* and drive via *Bolzano*, through the Dolomites to *Cortina d'Ampezzo* (stop for lunch). Continue via *Belluno* and *Treviso* to arrive *Piazzale Rome* in *Venice*. Transfer by gondola to hotel in *Venice*.

Oct. 20—Forenoon city sightseeing tour on foot, including English-speaking guide. Afternoon at leisure for independent activities. Optional excursion city tour by gondola. Overnight *Venice*.

Oct. 21—Transfer by gondola from hotel to railway station in *Venice* to take first class train via *Milan* and *Simplon Pass* to *Geneva*, to arrive in the late afternoon.

Oct. 22—Transfer by motorcoach from hotel to *Geneva Airport Cointrin*.
