Fatty acid statistics revised

Statistics for December production and disposition of fatty acids have been revised by the Fatty Acid Producers Council. The original figures were published in the March JAOCS. Revisions (in thousand pounds) are as follows: Unsaturated acids, oleic acid, finished goods inventories as of Nov. 30, 1977, 10,537; disposition, domestic shipments, MD 2,898; finished goods inventories as of Dec. 31, 1977, 10,905. Total unsaturated fatty acids, finished goods inventories as of Nov. 30, 22,203; finished goods inventories as of Dec. 31, 22,069. Saturated acids, hydrogenated animals and vegetable acids, minimum stearic content 70%, finished goods inventories as of Nov. 31, 2,634; production, 3,551; domestic shipments; 2,282; total disposition, 3,662; and finished goods inventories as of Dec. 31, 2,802. Revised figures in the same categories for high palmitic were 1,062; 1,370; 311; 824; and 1,608, respectively.

U.S. fats and oils exports

The USDA's Economics, Statistics, and Cooperative Services reports that U.S. exports of soybeans totaled 15,156,000 metric tons during fiscal year 1977, with a total value of \$6.4 billion dollars. Protein meal sales totaled 4,336,000 metric tons, valued at \$965 million. Vegetable oils and waxes totaled 1,223,000 metric tons, valued at \$776 million. Fats, oils, and greases totaled 1,399,000 metric tons, valued at \$579 million. Total value of all exported oilseeds and products combined with animal fats, oils, and greases was nearly \$7 billion of the U.S. total agricultural exports of \$24 billion.
