

640 Attend Delhi Conference

Approximately 640 persons attended the International Congress on Oilseeds and Oils held during February in New Delhi, India, with more than 20 nations represented by delegates.

Fourteen plenary lectures and 140 technical papers were presented during the meeting. Dr. W.O. Lundberg, former AOCS president, was among the plenary speakers, talking on "Present Status of Knowledge of Dietary Requirements for Essential Fatty Acids."

The event was sponsored by the Oil Technologists Association of India with numerous other organizations, including the AOCS, serving as cosponsors.
