## Mounts, Pryde address North Central meeting

Approximately 45 persons attending a North Central section meeting in Peoria, Illinois heard reports on effects of processing on fats and oils and on industrial uses of fats and oils.

North Central Section members were invited to tour the USDA's Northern Regional Research Center in Peoria before the dinner meeting. Peoria chapter American Chemical Society members attended the dinner afterward.

Tim Mounts described the processing required in use of various types of vegetable oils and the effects such processing has on the oil's quality. Everett Pryde described nonedible uses of vegetable oils, including recent work that has produced compounds with potential industrial use. Pryde also noted the NRRC has begun work on use of hybrid fuels or mixtures of diesel fuel or gasoline with nonpetro-leum-derived substances.  $\hfill \square$


