AOCS short course taking shape

Six persons have been confirmed as speakers for "Detergents Eight-O," the AOCS Short Course on soaps and detergents to be held Sept. 14-17, 1980, at Hershey, Pennsylvania.

Helmut Stupel, chairman for the session on constraints on the industry, has announced three speakers. George C. Schweiker of Philadelphia Quartz will present a review paper on major possibilities for phosphate replacements; SDA President Ted Brenner will speak on government influence on the industry; and Dr. F. Kennedy of Conoco Chemicals Co. will present a paper on raw materials.
