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## Sudan eyes U.S. tallow

The National Renderers Association says Sudan is turning to imported tallow to replace declining domestic cotton-seed oil as a raw material for that African nation's soap industry. The cottonseed oil also is needed for edible purposes, the May 15 issue of NRA's Renditions said.

The potential market for U.S. tallow during the next few years was estimated at 30,000 to 40,000 metric tons, for which purchase will be supported by an AID loan of approximately \$12 million.

NRA also said Egypt is building a tank terminal for the unloading of tallow. Egypt has been a major customer for U.S. tallow exports.  $\Box$ 

## Lipid colloquium to be in Lisbon

A colloquium on lipid metabolism and its pathology will be held Dec. 8-11, 1980, in Lisbon, with emphasis on lipoprotein structure and metabolism, hyperlipidemia, lipids and coagulation, phospholipids, lipidosis and techniques of lipid study.

On Dec. 12-13, a practical course will be organized covering hyperlipidemia screening; high resolution, thin layer chromatography, ultracentrifugation, electrophoresis and methods for the study of apoprotein and HDL cholesterol.
