1,400 at IFSCC meeting

Nearly 1,400 persons from 32 countries attended the 12th Congress of the International Federation of Societies of Cosmetic Chemists Sept. 13-17, 1982, at the Palais de Congrès, Paris, France.

The technical program, covering 3½ days, included 36 formal lectures and almost 60 poster communications on the theme "Cosmetic Technology and Science."

The 1982 IFSCC Award of 4,00 Swiss francs for the most meritorious paper at the congress was won by T. Suzuki, H. Tsutsumi and A. Ishida of the Kao Soap Company, Japan, for their paper, "Secondary Droplet Emulsion: Contribution of Liquid Crystal Formation to Physicochemical Properties and Skin Moisturizing Effect of Cosmetic Emulsion." Two honorable mentions went to J. Scaudel, J.A. Reinstein and N. Brudney of Laboratoire Lachartre, France, and to U. Zeidler and G. Reese of Henkel KGaA, Germany.
