Oleochemical conference registration begins

Registration has begun for the World Conference on Oleochemicals to be held Sept. 18-23, 1983, in Montreux, Switzerland.

The conference is designed as an international conference for discussion of the latest technological, marketing and economic factors in the oleochemical industry to provide a better understanding of that industry. The program will feature speakers from Switzerland, West Germany, the United States, England, Belgium, The Netherlands, Sweden and Malaysia. The tentative technical program was published in the May JAOCS.

Persons wishing to attend may use the registration form in this issue of JAOCS. If it already has been removed, additional copies are available from the World Conference on Oleochemicals, Meetings Coordinator, AOCS; 508 S. Sixth St., Champaign, IL 61820, USA. Registration fee is \$340 if received by Aug. 15; after that date the registration fee is \$375.

Accompanying the conference will be an exposition featuring exhibits by suppliers to the oleochemical industry. Both the conference and the exposition will be held in the convention center in Montreux.

Conference organizers have divided the meeting into nine sessions: marketing and economics; processing and production; fatty acids, derivatives; raw materials, feedstocks and intermediates; energy and environment; fatty alcohols and derivatives; nitrogen fatty chemicals; fatty chemical applications and analysis; and fatty chemicals, new chemistry.

Two sessions will be held each day, except on Wednesday. After the formal plenary sessions, there will be discussion groups each afternoon. Only one session will be held Wednesday to permit all conference registrants to participate in an afternoon boat excursion on Lake Geneva. Two other social events also are planned: a reception at the Montreux Palace Hotel on Sunday evening, Sept. 17; and a Swiss Evening at the Montreux Casino on Thursday, Sept. 22. A spouses' program has been arranged for persons accompanying technical registrants. Fee information is on the registration form.

North American registrants may obtain information on low-cost air fares and possible post-conference tours by checking the box on the form concerning "Group Travel from U.S.A." Registrants may wish to depart the U.S.A. on Friday, Sept. 16, to permit a day of rest in Europe on Saturday, Sept. 17, and arrive in Montreux on Sunday, Sept. 18, in time to attend the opening social event on Sunday evening.
