Visits, exhibit complement program







Registrants for the World Conference on Processing of Palm, Palm Kernel and Coconut Oils will receive technical information not only in the formal sessions of the conference, but also through industrial site visits and an expanded exposition.

The conference will be held Nov. 11 through 16, 1984, in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. Industrial site visits will be held Thursday afternoon, Nov. 15. A limited number of spaces are available for the industrial site visits. Persons wishing to participate should so indicate on the registration form. The fee charged is to defray transportation costs. In addition to the Thursday afternoon nearby industrial site visits, there will be a post conference tour on Saturday, Nov. 17, to more distant industrial complexes. Registrants from outside Malaysia also are invited on Saturday, Nov. 17, to attend the formal dedication of a \$12 million oleochemical plant recently completed by Henkel Oleochemicals, Jomalina Sdn. Bhd. and Socoil Corporation Bhd. The various site visits will provide registrants with a chance to see practical

application of the topics being discussed during the technical sessions.

Further complementing the educational opportunities will be the exposition accompanying the conference in the Hilton Hotel. Exhibitors will be suppliers of services and equipment to the fats and oils industries. Registrants will have ample time to visit exhibit booths to see the latest developments by these firms.

Contributed papers are required to be 20 minutes in length, including any time the author may want to use for questions from the audience.

Persons whose abstracts are accepted will be notified during early 1985 by the program committee.
