MURRAY GLAUBERMAN




AOCS member Murray Glauberman died Aug. 16, 1987, in Cleveland, Ohio. He was 59 years old. Mr. Glauberman was president and founder of Malco Products Inc. of Barberton, Ohio. Under his leadership, Malco Products became one of the leading contract and private label soap, detergent and chemical producers and packagers in the industry. Malco also developed and marketed a line of products under its own brand name for the grocery, housewares, automotive and sanitary maintenance markets.

He served as chairman of the board of the Chemical Specialties Manufacturers Association (CSMA) during 1986; he first was elected to the CSMA board in 1982 and served as second vice chairman of the board in 1983. He joined AOCS in 1951. He also was a member of the American Society for Testing and Materials.

He received his B.S. degree in chemistry in 1948 from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. Prior to founding Malco Products, he was a plant manager for Kamen Soap Products and Phipps Products and a chemist with Nopyron Corp.


