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GUEST EDITOR'S PREFACE

The Korea-Japan Joint Forum, Organic Materials for Electronics and Photonics, KJF 2000, held at Kyoto Research Park, Kyoto on October 4-6, 2000, was a series following on from the first forum, KJF'89, held in Korea Institute of Science and Technology (KIST), Seoul in 1989. The main objective of this forum was to discuss on the recent progress in organic materials research, and to promote collaboration between Korea and Japan in those fields. The forum covers the following 5 topics: (1) Electro-luminescence, (2) Optical Properties and Devices, (3) Fabrication and Characterization, (4) Molecular Recognition, Sensor and Bioelectronics, and (5) Novel Techniques and Molecular Electronics.

The Program of the forum consisted of 13 invited lectures, 18 oral presentations, and 97 poster contributions. More than 150 scientists and students from both countries attended this conference, including 72 from Korea and 80 from Japan. After usual reviewing, 90 out of the submitted papers were selected for publication in this special issue of *Molecular Crystals and Liquid Crystals*
