

Preface

The first edition of the International Directory of Mycorrhizologists was distributed on the occasion of the 5th NACOM, which took place at Laval University, Quebec City, in 1981. It was the beginning of a new era in the mycorrhiza research world. Since then, an updated edition has been prepared and distributed to participants at each NACOM.

A few months ago, Dr. Dieter Czeschlik, life sciences editor at Springer, offered to assume future publication and distribution of the directory. This initiative is being realized with the First International Conference on Mycorrhizae (ICOM), held at Berkeley, California, on 4–9 August 1996. It is very gratifying to see that Springer will continue to respond to mycorrhizologists' communication needs. In the foreword of the

4th edition (1990), Dr. James M. Trappe wrote: "Science remains a very human endeavor.
