

# Erratum: Fatty Acid Derivatives of Clozapine: Prolonged Antidopaminergic Activity of Docosahexaenoylclozapine in the Rat<sup>☆</sup>

In our recent report on the pharmacology of fatty-acid amide derivatives of clozapine, (Baldessarini RJ, Campbell A, Webb NL, Swindell CS, Flood JG, Shashoua VE, Kula NS, Hemamalini S, Bradley MO: Fatty Acid Derivatives of Clozapine: Prolonged Antidopaminergic Activity of Docosahexaenoylclozapine in the Rat. *Neuropsychopharmacology* 2001; 24:55–65), we incorrectly identified

Novartis Corporation as the source of clozapine used in preparing the novel derivatives described. Instead, clozapine was obtained initially from Sigma Chemical Co. of St. Louis, MO, in small quantities, and then in larger amounts from Alexis Corporation, CH4448 Laufelfinger, Switzerland. The authors regret any confusion arising from this incorrect information in our report.
