We are happy to welcome Professor Manfred Bochmann of the University of East Anglia as the first foreign Associate Editor of *Organometallics*. Professor Bochmann began his studies in chemistry at the University of Marburg in Germany and continued them at Imperial College in London, where he obtained his Ph.D., working with Professor Geoffrey Wilkinson. After a three-year stint at the ICI Corporate Laboratory, he joined the Chemistry Department of the University of East Anglia in the U.K. in 1983, where he currently is Head of Chemistry and Professor of Inorganic Chemistry.

Professor Bochmann has a distinguished record of excellent research in organometallic chemistry, which was recognized in 2002 with the award of the Royal Society of Chemistry Medal for Organometallic Chemistry.
