Cyclodextrins and Their Industrial Uses. Edited by Dominique Duchene. Editions de Sante, Paris. The authors of this work include Prof. F. Cramer of the Institute Max Planck in Göttingen, Prof. K. Uekama of the University of Kumamoto, Prof. J. Szejli of Budapest, Prof. E Smolkovà Keulemnansovà of the Charles University in Prague, and in France, Profs. B. Sébille, G. Tsoucaris, and D. Duchene. The book with a preface by Prof. N. A. Peppas, offers a short history of cyclodextrins and a basic review of clathrates and solid inclusion compounds. The next 10 chapters present cyclodextrin production, structure, metabolism, and toxicity, and analytical methods for inclusion compounds, cosmetics, and food additives. Presented in English, the book contains 448 pages with 1096 references, 135 figures, and 83 tables. 1987. French and foreign price: 745,000 Fr.
