AAPS FOUNDATION

The AAPS Foundation enhances pharmaceutical science research and increases the development of scientists who are prepared to conduct research with an even greater level of skill. AAPS is committed to the principle that 100% of your tax-deductible contribution goes directly toward the foundation's programs.

With support from our donors, the AAPS Foundation will award five Graduate Student Fellowships and one New Investigator Grant in 2015. Graduate Student Fellowships awardees will receive \$10,000 each and will be eligible for a second year award, contingent upon progress in research. Fellowships are open to all schools/depart- ments, including allied pharmaceutical disciplines (e.g., chemistry, biology, engineering, mathematics, and statis-tics) but applicant thesis research must be relevant to pharmaceutical sciences. One New Investigator Grant awardee will receive \$40,000. The New Investigator Grant is open to full-time (12 and 9 month) tenured and non-tenured faculty with 3 years or less as assistant professor at the start of the grant application.
