

## Association News and Announcements

### AAPS STRATEGIC PLAN

All records for meeting attendance by pharmaceutical scientists were broken when 1595 paid attendees were joined by invited speakers and scientific exhibitors to bring the total attendance at the First AAPS National Meeting and Exposition, held November 2-6, 1986, in Washington, D.C., to 1866!

On the evening of November 4, 1986, AAPS President Leslie Z. Benet presented his "State of the Association" address to 1363 banquet attendees. He reported that association membership was over 2800 and that over one-half of the membership had not previously been members of the Academy of Pharmaceutical Sciences.

At the close of his talk, Dr. Benet reviewed the scenario for the year 2000 as approved in the association's 1986 Strategic Plan.

In the year 2000, AAPS is envisioned as having:

1. A membership of 10,000-15,000 scientists.
2. Each section producing its own publication.
3. A staff of about 20-30 individuals, with the strong member volunteer effort continuing.
4. Its own building.
5. A yearly budget of approximately \$2 million with only about one-third being derived from dues.
6. An annual meeting with an attendance of approximately 5000.
7. About six regional meetings annually as well as local discussion groups in all geographic areas having a concentration of pharmaceutical scientists.
8. Approximately 20 of its members elected to the National Academy of Sciences or an equivalent, such as the Institute of Medicine.
9. 1000 international members. The association will exert a strong influence world-wide and will hold meetings in Europe and the Far East.
10. A reputation as the *premiere* organization of pharmaceutical scientists.
