*Index Nominum 1987*, 13th ed., edited and published by the Laboratory of the Swiss Pharmaceutical Society of Zurich, 1987, xv + 1112 pp., \$140.00. Distributed in the U.S. and Canada by Drug Intelligence Publications, Inc., 1241 Broadway, Hamilton, Illinois 62341. This one-volume work is made up of an alphabetical list of generic and trade names of internationally available drug products containing one active substance. Information is given on international nonproprietary names (INN), therapeutic classification, chemical name, structural formula, generic name, trade names and manufacturers, as well as listings of the source of pharmaceutical monographs on each drug. This new edition contains over 4000 compounds and derivatives and more than 36,000 synonyms.
