CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

AAPS Fellow

AAPS is seeking the names of individuals to be considered as candidates to receive the honor of becoming an AAPS Fellow. An AAPS Fellow is defined as a distinguished AAPS member who is an acknowledged leader and outstanding contributor to the pharmaceutical sciences and who has been elected to Fellowship status by the AAPS Executive Council.

Eligibility Requirements: Selection of an AAPS Fellow is based on professional competence which is reflected through scholarly and research contributions to the pharmaceutical sciences such as original articles and patents. Evaluations will be based on merit rather than quantity, and evaluation bodies should consider the impact of the nominee's contributions. An outstanding scholar's achievements should influence the way others think and act. Evidence of importance of a nominee's contributions should be sought through a variety of indicators such as: research achievement awards, invitations to speak at national and international meetings, grants or fellowship awards, and citation analysis.

The nominee should be a recognized leader in the pharmaceutical sciences as evidenced by election and appointment to offices and committees of national and international organizations. Specific service contributions to AAPS and other scientific organizations/associations should be considered as a part of the nominee's leadership activities.

Fellows Nominations Procedure

Nomination Materials (Original and 15 copies):

1. Nominee Information Sheet (see p. 127).
2. Nominee's current *Curriculum vitae*.
3. Nominee's Assessment Abstract (1-2 page summary of why the nominator feels the nominee meets eligibility requirements)—NOT to exceed 2 single-spaced, typed 8½" × 11" pages.
4. Letters of Recommendation (2) (If more than 2 are provided, only the first 2 will be distributed.)
5. Deadline for submission of nomination materials to the AAPS Office is *April 29, 1988*.

Fellows Selection Procedure

Section Fellows Selection Committees comprised of three to five members will be charged with nominating worthy candidates. Nominations received at the AAPS Office will be forwarded to the appropriate Section Fellows Selection Committee for consideration. Only current AAPS Fellows (from former APhA/APS Fellows) shall serve on Section Fellows Selection Committees.

The candidates forwarded through open solicitation and the Section Selection Committees will then be evaluated by the AAPS Fellows Selection Committee (a subcommittee of the AAPS Executive Council), which will be comprised of a Chairman and a representative of each Section in which nominations are received. Names of nominees forwarded by the AAPS Fellows Selection Committee must be approved by the full AAPS Executive Council before the honor may

be bestowed. An award ceremony will be scheduled during the AAPS Third Annual Meeting in Orlando, Florida.

Research Achievement Awards

AAPS is seeking nominations for six Research Achievement Awards to be presented at the 1988 Annual Meeting in Orlando, Florida, October 30 to November 3. These awards are intended to recognize outstanding scientists who have conducted fundamental research that has had significant impact in the fields represented by the AAPS sections; that is, pharmaceutical technology; pharmaceuticals and drug delivery; pharmacodynamics, pharmacokinetics and drug metabolism; medicinal and natural product chemistry; analysis and pharmaceutical quality; and economic, marketing, and management sciences.

AAPS plans to bestow future research achievement awards every two years within each section; however, the schedule of awards will be staggered after 1988 so that awards will be bestowed at each year's annual meeting.

Awards Nominations Procedure

Nomination Materials (Original and 15 copies).

1. Nominations may be made only by AAPS members.
2. Biographical information on a standard form (or facsimile) available on p. 128. Also, a copy of the *curriculum vitae* may be included, but should not replace the standard form.
3. Reprints or photocopies of up to three individual articles that support the quality and originality of the research and clearly identify the concept developed.
4. A complete bibliography of published research is desired, but any publication list should have up to 10 key publications identified by asterisks.
5. A summary of a nominee's major research accomplishments stated in such a way that a person from another discipline can appreciate the significance and uniqueness of the nominee's contribution. (This may NOT exceed 2 single-spaced, typed 8½" × 11" pages.)
6. At least 2 additional supporting letters that speak specifically and exclusively to the research accomplishments of the nominee. At least 2 of the statements either supporting or nominating the individual should come from scientists not currently nor recently based at the home institution of the nominee. This does not exclude additional letters from scientists at the home institution. All supporting letters must be submitted with the nomination packet.
7. Nominations and supportive materials are to be sent as a single packet to the AAPS Office so that they are received by *June 15, 1988*.

Awards Selection Procedure

Nominations will be reviewed by the appropriate section awards committee and the names of eligible nominees will be forwarded to the AAPS Executive Council for final approval.

Award recipients will receive a \$2,000 honorarium and reimbursed expenses to attend the 1988 AAPS Annual Meeting.
