2001 AAPS Annual Meeting and Exposition

Scientists from around the world will learn, network and explore new scientific research and technologies at the 2001 AAPS Annual Meeting and Exposition in Denver, Colorado, October 21-25. More than 8,000 pharmaceutical scientists will explore the theme, "Pharmaceutical Sciences: Climbing New Heights" and present close to 2,000 contributed papers featuring important scientific findings.

The Opening Session will feature keynote speaker Donald P. Francis, M.D., D.Sc., President and Co-Founder of VaxGen, Inc. Dr. Francis is one of the world's most widely recognized scientists in the field of AIDS. His efforts to call attention to the AIDS threat and warn of the inadequacy of the public health response were chronicled in the book and movie *And the Band Played On*, journalist Randy Shilts' account of the early years of the AIDS epidemic.

The meeting will offer more than 70 educational sessions including symposia, short courses, and round-table discussions. Topics to be presented include:

- Genomics: Impact on Drug Discovery and Marketing in the New Millennium (Implications of the Human Genome Project)
- The Successes and Challenges of Bioinformatics and Pharmacogenomics in Drug Discovery and Development
- Emerging Pharmaceutics Strategies for More Efficient Drug Candidate Identification
- Penetration of Drugs and Macromolecules in Solid Tumors
- Role of Drug Transporters in the Brain
- Novel Tools to Study the Mechanisms, Expression and Regulation of Drug Transporters

Scientists that submitted an abstract online for the 2001 AAPS Annual Meeting can check the status(acceptance or rejection) of their abstract by using a secure login and password, provided by AAPS, after July 5, 2001. The online system will present a formatted acceptance or rejection notice for each abstract submitted. AAPS Short Course on Computer Simulation and Its Role in Drug Development Research

AAPS will present a short course on the topic of Monte Carlo Simulation and how it can be used as a research tool in drug development. The course will not feature information about using software, but about identifying the special challenges that such simulations present. This didactic course is designed for pharmacokineticists and clinical pharmacologists who want to understand the nature of Monte Carlo Simulation, how it can be used to answer questions that traditional methods of modeling cannot answer and how Monte Carlo Simulation is used in relation to clinical trial simulation. The short course will take place in September 2001 in the Washington, DC area.
