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AAPS Workshop on Clinical Biomarkers in Drug Development: Efficacy Assessment, Pharmacokinetics and Pharmacodynamics and Regulatory Insights

November 5 - 6, 2004 Holiday Inn Inner Harbor Baltimore, MD

This program will be a two-day workshop designed for scientists in academia, industry and regulatory agencies focused on the evaluation and integration of biomarkers into the drug development process as well as clinical practice. The first day of the program will consist of a general overview of pre-clinical and early clinical use of biomarkers, examples of successful clinical efficacy studies with biomarkers and exposure topics highlighting pharmacokinetic and pharmacodynamic analysis methods. The second day will be devoted to addressing statistical evaluation approaches used in biomarkers analysis, and the clinical validation of biomarkers. The afternoon of the second day will provide regulatory perspectives of biomarkers in safety and efficacy study with pertinent applicable cases studies based on the FDA's Exposure Response Guidance.
