A supplement is available which provides details for the construction and operation of the pneumatic syringe and its electronic control unit, plus instructions for the special programs listed in the publication. On the basis of two years experience, a revision of the supplement was advisable. The revisions include correction of errors, rewriting ambiguous sections, improvements in design of both syringe and control unit, and most important, listing of alternate components for those which are now no longer commercially available.
