Rejected manuscripts can be revised and resubmitted for more extensive review according to standard procedures. Rapid Communications must not exceed four printed pages in length, including illustrations, tables and references. In addition, manuscripts must adhere to other requirements as stated in our Instructions to Authors. Authors should indicate that the article is being submitted as a Rapid Communication.
