V International Neurobiological Symposium – Magdeburg, D.D.R.

5–8 June, 1977

The Society for Neurosciences and the Society of Pharmacology and Toxicology of the German Democratic Republic are organizing the 5th International Symposium on current problems in Neurobiology to be held in Magdeburg, from 5–8 June, 1977. The Scientific Chairman will be Professor H. Matthies, Magdeburg. The official language of the meeting will be English.
