The following matter was inadvertently omitted during the printing of the plates in this issue. It should have appeared under figure 62, facing plate 10.

DESCRIPTION OF PLATE 10 AND FIGURE 62

Aysheaia pedunculata Walcott, 1911, U.S.N.M. 235882, oblique lateral, part only. Phyllopod bed, Walcott quarry. FIGURES 57, 58. Entire, respectively east, reflected (magn. × 5).

FIGURE 59. Posterior portion, east (magn. × 10).

FIGURE 60. Dorsal margin of trunk opposite R 2-4 (m, solid line, in figure 62), showing triangular projections, reflected (magn. \times 15).

FIGURE 61. Trunk and proximal portions of R 2-4, showing annulations and circumflex-shaped ridges at base of triangular projections, east (magn. × 10). Dorsal margin indicated by m, dashed line, in figure 62.

FIGURE 62. Explanatory drawing.
