

Some New observations about the Planet Mars, communicated since the Printing of the former sheets.

There was very lately produced a Paper, containing some observations, made by Mr. *Hook*, about the Planet *Mars*; in the *Face* whereof he affirmed to have discovered, in the late months of *February* and *March*, that there are several *Macule* or *Spotted parts*, changing their place, and not returning to the same Position, till the next ensuing night near about the same time. Whence it may be collected, that *Mars* (as well as *Jupiter*, and the *Earth*, &c.) does move about his own *Axis*. of which a fuller account will be given hereafter, God permitting. This short and hasty intimation of it, is intended onely to invite others, that have opportunity, timely to make Observations, (either to confirm, or rectify) before *Mars* gets out of sight.
