

10th. is to shew the easiness there is in reducing other *Fortifications* (provided they have second *Plans*) to this manner, without altering the *Face* of the *Bastion*, the *Motes*, or the *Outworks*. The 11th. is the *Plane* of the *City of Dunkirk*, with the *Antient Fortifications*, upon which are placed also the *new ones* (of the *Author*) that both *Methods* may be the better compared together. The 12th. is a *Plane* of the *City of Maastricht* and its *old Fortifications* but reform'd after this *new* manner.
