

*The Description of a Stone of the Bladder, seen
by the Royal Society, Feb. 25th, 1684.*

THIS Stone is represented *Fig. 1.* and is said to be taken out of the *Bladder* of one *Francis Dugood* of *Auchenhove* in *Aberdeen*. The man, who bred it, lived till he was 50 years old: the length of it is $5\frac{2}{10}$ Inches; the Diameter $3\frac{6}{10}$; the weight two Pound, three Ounces, and six Drams.

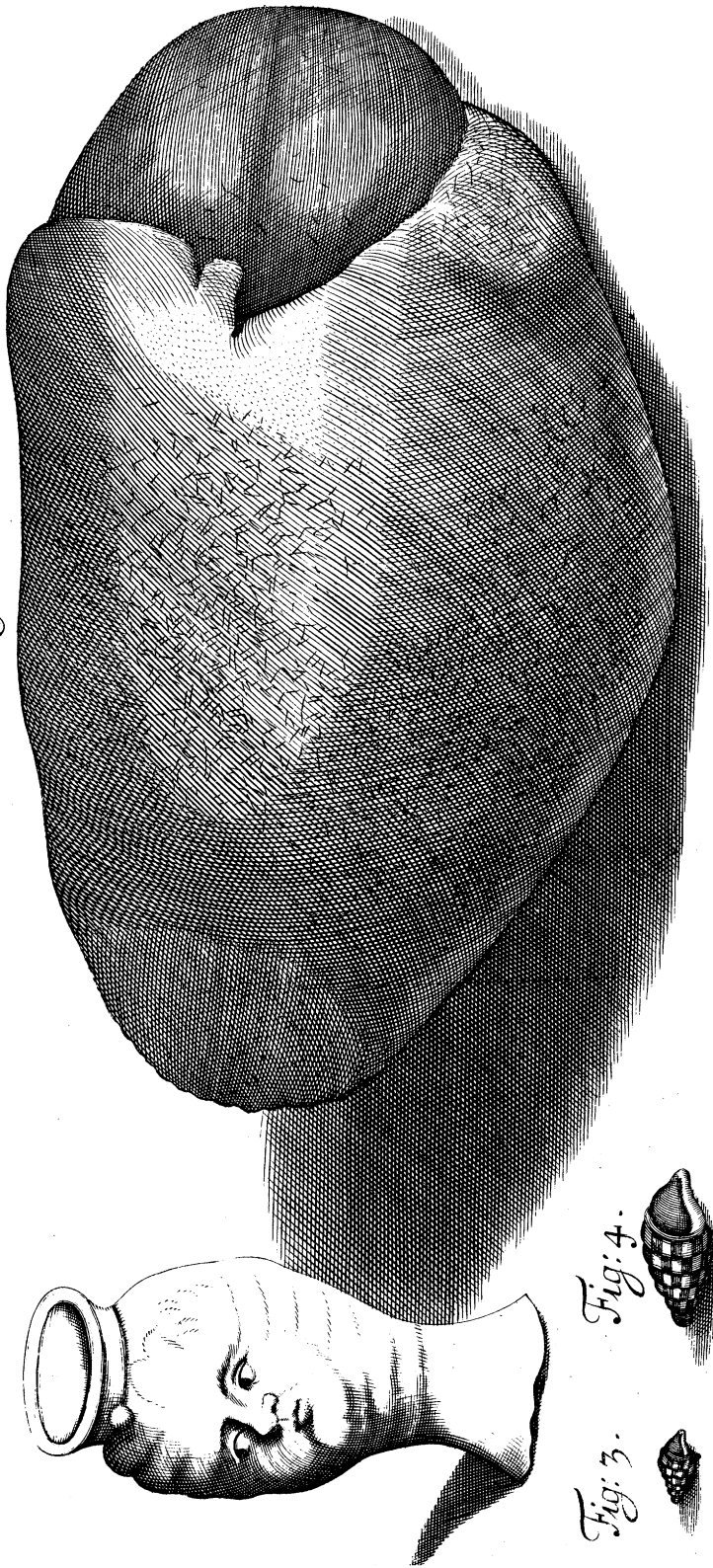
