XV. *An Account of Books now Printing beyond Sea.*

**D**R. *Volcamer* is Printing a Catalogue of the Plants about *Nurenberg*; with the Exoticks of his Garden, with Figures. *Dr. Baglivi*, at *Rome*, is Printing a Book *De Fibra Motrice, de Lympha & Pinguedine Morbisq; ab iis dependentibus*. *Senr. Bulifon* is Printing the Lives of the famous Men of the Kingdom of *Naples*, with their Effigies. *Abbate Maruscelli*, as also a *French* Bookseller, at *Rome*, are about writing an universal Catalogue of Books, *Secundum Materias*; the first, as he says, has already done above 140,000 Volumes. *Monfig Strozzi* is writing the Lives of the Popes; illustrated by their Medals. *Signior Abbate Nazari* is about re-printing the *Giornale de Letterati*.

Father *Plumier* will publish a Book called, *Filicetum Americanum*. *Monsieur Du Hamel*, Author of the *Philosophical Systeme*, has almost ended his History of the *Academie Royale* of Sciences at *Paris*.
