*LIX. Some Account of the Animal sent from  
the East Indies, by General Clive, to his  
Royal Highness the Duke of Cumberland,  
which is now in the Tower of London: In  
a Letter from James Parsons, M. D.  
F. R. S. to the Rev. Tho. Birch, D. D.  
Secretary to the Royal Society.*

Read March 27, 1760. AT the request of the Reverend Dr. Littleton, dean of Exeter, I went to observe this creature, in order to find what class of animals he belonged to; and made the drawing,
