CHEMOSYSTEMATICS, PRINCIPLES AND PRACTICE

An International Symposium on Chemosystematics, Principles and Practice will be held at Southampton University, 10–12 July, 1979. The 12 years since the Association's pioneer symposium "Chemotaxonomy and Serotaxonomy" have seen a massive expansion of chemosystematic work. Contributors from a range of zoological and botanical disciplines will review new developments and draw together the principles on which

chemical data now contribute to systematics as a whole. Particular emphasis will be given to modern methods of analysing these data. Contributions are invited for a poster session.
