




- 4. Cooperate in raising the general competence of the profession by advising and assisting fellow members who want to advance their knowledge and skill in piano technology.


#### Piano Technicians Guild Code Of Professional Ethics

- 6. I will not advertise in a manner so as to convey information that is misleading.

- 1. Members other than Registered Craftsmen shall not, by omission or misrepresentation, imply that they have PTG Craftsman rating.





#### PTG's Texas Roundup

#### Dallas 1990

Now at last for those technicians who wish to improve their tuning skills just look at the lineup of tuning classes, tuning workshops, and instructors listed below.

You will have to agree, with all the tuning classes and different instructors it is going to be one great tuning session at the Dallas Institute. Don't forget to bring your tuning tool along for the tuning workshops and if you are taking a tuning exam you will feel more comfortable with your own tuning tools.

There are over 50 technical and tuning classes and forums, which in other words are in-depth and hands-on in the piano trade. I also want to mention that for some of these classes you will need a few tools for regulation and voicing, and a few dull chisels and knives for the toolsharpening class. These workshop classes will be limited, so first come — first served.

Don't forget our special class on "Refinishing" with Brent Fisher of the Dallas Chapter instructing and Dwight Pile of the Toronto Chapter doing the instructing on "Polyester Touch Up." Both of these classes will be hands-on to get the real feel and technique of this important part of piano work. Transportation will be provided to and from the hotel and Tyson's Piano Store where the class will be held in their piano rebuilding shop. This is a full-day class of four periods with Brent doing a half day and Dwight doing the other half. Again this will be a limited class and will only be scheduled for two separate days, so first come—first served.

There was a time when only a few top rebuilders put in pinb locks; however, in the past few years we have had many classes on this subject of installing new piblocks. Now this is standard procedure in rebuilding a quality grand piano. At the present time not too many technicians include installing a soundboard in their grand rebuilding. Are you ready for this? Nick Gravagne of the New Mexico Chapter is doing a one-and-a-half-day special class on this very subject titled, "Soundboard Replacement." Assisting Nick in this special class will be Jim Geiger of the Houston,

TX, Chapter and his son Dave Geiger of the Cincinnati, OH, Chapter. This will be a first for this type of class at a PTG Annual Convention Institute. You have been reading Nick's articles in the PTG Journal for the past few years—now you can see him in action and have him teach you this special part of rebuilding a grand piano. You will have to sign up early to get a reserved seat for this one-time class of 50 people.

We have many new institute instructors along with a few piano companies, and this will be their first time to offer a class at our Institute. Another extra attraction we could arrange at this hotel is to have most of the suppliers demonstrate their special new tools, better supplies, glues, etc. Now you will have a chance not only to see them, but to try them out! Won't that be great? We will have new classes and standard type classes with new instructors with a different approach to the subject. Our business classes will be extremely important and definitely related to your piano business, so be sure to have your notebook with you.

This Dallas Institute will be a real educational treat for all who attend. You will know what I mean when you read in next month's Journal a short description of each class and see the pictures of all the Institute instructors. I'm sure you will really be excited when you finish the Institute section of the May Journal. By now you should have a registration brochure which will tell you of other events, so fill out your registration form and send it in immediately to the Home Office. We don't want you to miss the "PTG's Texas Roundup," and all the good times at our PTG Annual Convention or a room at the Hyatt Regency Hotel. The June Journal will have the complete Institute schedule for you to work out your schedule of classes before you get to the convention. Let me warn you, with over 90 Institiute classes, it will be a real job to fit in all the classes you want to see. However, you will have fun doing it, so good luck. Get ready soon for the PTG's Texas Roundup and let us put our brand on you!

#### Remembering When In Dallas, Texas

When I was a boy of 15, I sat in a high school physical science class in Baltimore, MD, bored as usual. It was my last class and I was waiting for the bell to ring. Suddenly, there was a scratch of static on the classroom loud speaker, followed by the drone of a newscaster's voice that sounded serious. In the next moment, we as a class, were to find out that the President of the United States had been shot while riding in a motorcade in Dallas, TX, and had been rushed to a hospital where he was pronounced dead. I remember the stunned look on all my classmates' faces and the absolute and uncharacteristic quiet in the halls as we shuffled aimlessly in disbelief. The nation was to mourn for the young Kennedy for weeks after that day.

The Stock Market Crash, The Great Depression, the attack on Pearl Harbor — moments in history that seemed to take America by the collar and bring it to attention. But for me, the event indelibly imprinted in my mind would have to be the assasination of President Kennedy.

If you are old enough, you might ask yourself where you were when John Kennedy was killed. My guess is that you will be able to pinpoint the time, place and circumstances with amazing accuracy.

As you know, this summer the PTG National Convention will be in Dallas, TX. The Hyatt Regency Hotel is located on the outside edge of the Dallas skyline. Within walking distance from the hotel is the Kennedy Memorial. Close by, the Texas School Book Depository, the building from which Lee Harvey Oswald allegedly fired the fatal shots, has been preserved and transformed into a museum that houses information and memorbilia on the event.

So, tuners, when your pockets are full enough of exhibitors tools and accessories, when you've run out of anecdotes at the bar or your brain is filled to the brim with high pianistic knowledge...when you have a moment... you might take time to remember when...


